



Alyssa Cossey is Assistant Professor of Choral Music and Music Education at the University of Arizona where she conducts the University Community Chorus and the WildCat Choir, teaches Choral Methods and other music education courses, and oversees student teachers. In addition to her teaching responsibilities she is in high demand as a clinician, adjudicator, guest conductor and presenter and has presented at state and regional conferences in California, Washington, Hawaii, North Carolina, and Michigan. Dr. Cossey received her DMA in Choral Conducting from Michigan State University, her MM in Choral Conducting from California State University, Fullerton, and her BA from California State Polytechnic University, Pomona. Prior to pursuing her doctorate Dr. Cossey taught middle and high school choir in the Los Angeles area for nearly a decade. During her tenure her choirs consistently received Superior ratings at festival and enrollment in the Choral Department grew from less than 80 to more than 350 singers.
