

CALL FOR INTEREST SESSION PROPOSALS FOR THE 2019 CALIFORNIA CHORAL DIRECTORS ASSOCIATION (CCDA) STATE CONFERENCE

San Jose, CA

March 14-16, 2019

CCDA is issuing an open call for session proposals for the 2019 State Conference in San Jose. We are seeking sessions that are dynamic and interactive. These sessions should provide conference attendees with tools and techniques they can use immediately in their choral rehearsals. We encourage you to brainstorm proposals that will highlight successes you wish to share with colleagues in engaging sessions.

For instance,

- Have you created an original approach to choral pedagogy or to improving rehearsal techniques?
- Have you developed innovative programming techniques?
- Have you found success with movement in your rehearsals and/or performances?
- Have you discovered a method to work more successfully with changing voices?
- Do you have technology solutions for various pedagogical or administrative issues?
- Do you offer a fresh look at choir administration, leadership, recruitment, community outreach, or social media?

If you are a member of ACDA, you are welcome to submit a proposal. It is understood that CCDA will not assume financial responsibility for travel, food, or lodging for presenters or interest session participants. Submitting an application implies that the presenter and participants are prepared to travel and perform at the 2019 State Conference in San Jose.

IMPORTANT: We suggest that you first develop your submission proposal in Word and then copy/paste the information into the appropriate sections in the online form. The online form does not have spell check capability, so editing your information in advance will ensure greater accuracy. Please submit no more than two proposals.

Applications must be submitted online at www.calcda.org by 11:59 p.m. on Friday, May 18, 2018. All presenters who submitted a proposal will be notified by the CCDA State Conference Coordinator of their status no later than July 15, 2018.
